UNIVERSITY FUNDING

When the University has required financial support, the Foundation has delivered, providing resources to avoid state-mandated fiscal watch in 2016, 2017, and 2020.

Supporting students and delivering financial aid is the cornerstone of the Foundation. By providing scholarship opportunities, we allow more students to achieve their dreams.

CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE

The Foundation plays a key role in the purchase and acquisition of real estate for the University, as well as providing resources for construction and campus improvements.

To support the mission of the University, deliver financial aid, and ensure long-term viability, the Foundation develops and fosters a strong roster of donors and funding sources.
